

Value Power & Gas purchases all of its electric energy from the wholesale market. The generation resource mix shown below is based on EIA reporting of regional generation resources.

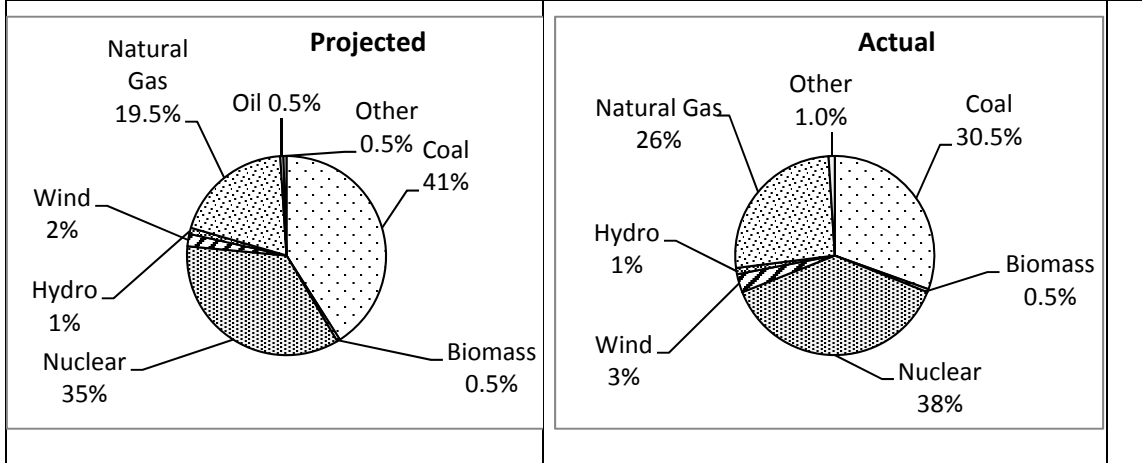

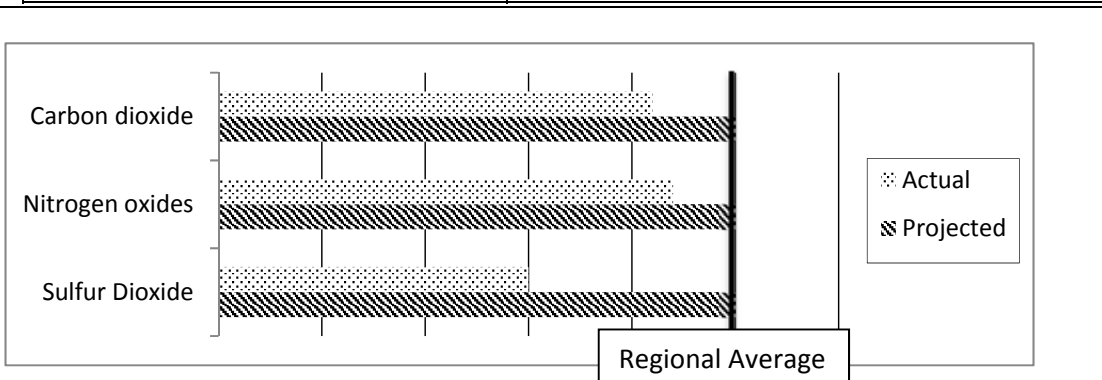
